Furlough extension for new parents

The UK Government confirmed yesterday (9th June) that employees on paternity and maternity leave who return to work in the coming months will still be eligible for the government's furlough scheme even after 10 June cut-off date. CITB Update

The CITB have announced that National Construction Colleges (NCCs) in England will reopen and resume face-to-face training in July however for those looking to train at the CITB's Inchinnan training centre in Scotland, the college remains closed for now.

Testing Centres

All Pearson Professional Centres in England delivering the Health, Safety and Environment (HS&E) test have reopened with the relevant social distancing precautions and safety measures in place however, in Scotland, they remain closed in line with the Scottish and Welsh governments' COVID-19 regulations and guidance. It is hoped this will be reviewed in Phase 2 (review due 18th June)
