# **COVID-19 - CECA SCOTLAND UPDATE**

#### Construction Sector to move to Phase 3 of Restart Plan

In today's daily update from the First Minister, Nicola Sturgeon, the construction sector in Scotland was given the go ahead to move to phase 3 of the Industry Restart Plan and then "move through the remaining phases subject to ongoing consultation with government".

In Phase 3 of Construction Scotland's <u>five stage plan</u>, which commences Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June, the sector can move to "Steady State Operation", provided that the sector continues to follow guidance on the safety and welfare of the workforce and the public. In line with earlier phases, only work that can be carried out within physical distancing guidelines or with physical barriers is permitted.
