#### **Updated CLC Site Operating Procedures**

The Construction Leadership Councils (CLC) Site Operating Procedures have been updated to reflect the latest UK Government guidance following the easing of lockdown measures in England from Saturday 4 July. The 'one metre plus' social distancing guidelines require workers to stay two metres apart, or one metre with risk mitigation where two metres is not viable. It is expected that sites will maintain the social distancing measures in place.

Whilst the CLC Site Operating Procedures (SOP) are only applicable to England & Wales please find a link <a href="here">here</a> to the updated SOP - Version 5 for your information. The wording used in the SOP in relation to 'one metre plus' is from the UK Government <a href="Construction and other outdoor work">Construction and other outdoor work</a> guidance.

Site operations in Scotland are still governed by the <u>Construction Scotland SOP</u> and are unaltered by the publication of this updated CLC SOP.

## Flexible Furlough Starts Today

Businesses will have the flexibility to bring furloughed employees back to work part time from today (1 July) as part of the UK Government's plan to re-open the UK and kick-start our economy. Employers now have the flexibility to decide the hours and shift patterns of their employees - with the government continuing to pay 80% of salaries for the hours they do not work. #### New HSE Musculoskeletal Disorders Online Assessment Tool

The HSE have launched a new <u>musculoskeletal disorders (MSD) tool</u> to simplify the process of completing assessments. Employers and safety representatives can use the tool to assess the risks posed by lifting, carrying and team manual handling activities. The assessor can then understand, interpret and categorise the level of risk, and implement the appropriate control measures. In addition, the automated management reports include:

- Tracking of assessments that have been completed
- Identification of priority areas and tasks for improvement
- Supports Identification of common themes across multiple departments/sites/locations
