Updated: COVID-19 Guidance on Staying Safe and Protecting Others

Scottish Government guidance, Staying Safe and Protecting Others (Physical Distancing) has been updated today (3rd July) and can be read in full <u>here</u>.

Promoting Skills and Employment

A group of industry experts on the Scottish Governments Enterprise and Skills Strategic Board, have today submitted an action plan to limit unemployment caused by the economic impacts of coronavirus (COVID-19). Their recommendations, will be considered by the Scottish Government alongside last week's report from the Advisory Group on Economic Recovery, include:

- an expansion of online opportunities for young people to find information on future jobs and training
- enhanced help for those facing redundancy, including the reshaping of the PACE redundancy support scheme with more frontline advisers, potentially through private sector secondment, volunteers and tailored support for businesses of all sizes

- maximising the flexibility of colleges and universities to offer short courses so people can learn critical skills needed by employers, including digital, automation, artificial intelligence and the transition to a net-zero economy
- assistance to support employee retention, including a 'toolkit' of measures to introduce new innovative work practices and upskill or reskill staff
- short placement schemes to give work experience to under-25s out of work for six months
- expansion of apprentice provision, including more off-the-job training opportunities where employers cannot accommodate learning in the workplace, and virtual learning in schools

Travel Restrictions Lifted

Final Phase 2 Measures Confirmed

Further to yesterday's Daily Update, details of the final Phase 2 measures can be read in full <u>here</u>, including information on mandatory face coverings and some exemptions from the 2 metre rule.

Obtaining Surety during COVID-19

The Insurance and Surety Working Group for the Construction Leadership Council COVID-9 Task Force have published guidance on obtaining surety during the pandemic, which can be read here. The guidance is aimed at helping SME's obtain bonds in the current climate. While bonds are often a key contractual requirement, Covid-19 has led to uncertainties surrounding reduced productivity and risk which has impacted on the accessibility of bonds in the supply chain. The guidance provides SME's with practical advice for use in discussions with brokers and providers when seeking bonds, including recommendations on the information that should be collected and presented. While it was designed to assist SMEs, it should be useful for all in the supply chain.

UK Wide Updates

No VAT on PPE until end of October

The temporary scrapping of VAT on PPE has been extended until the end of October, the government announced today. More details here.

Holidays Abroad this Summer

It has been announced today that from 10 July 2020 you will be able to travel to many countries without having to self-isolate on return to England, including Spain, Italy and France. The exemptions from self-isolation apply to all modes of international transport, including sea and international rail routes as well as flights. In addition, the Foreign and Commonwealth Office will shortly set out exemptions for a number of destinations from its global advisory against "all but essential" international travel, with changes coming into effect on 4th July. Scotland and the other devolved nations have yet to agree their own approach to exemptions, therefore travellers abroad from Scottish airports will still be subject to 14 days isolation until Scottish guidance is issued.
