CICV Call for School Building Action Plan

The Construction Industry Coronavirus Forum, of which CECA Scotland is a key member, has called for a school building action plan to help pupils return to full time education safely. The Forum has written to <u>Kevin Stewart, MSP</u>, the Minister for Local Government, Housing and Planning, outlining a series of practical proposals including repurposing existing vacant property near schools and building temporary accommodation in suitable locations with a common design approach, including fit-out, to ensure compliance with site operating procedures (SOPs).
