Apprenticeship Levy Pledge

CLC and CITB have been working with the Department for Education to develop a new Apprenticeship Levy (AL) Pledge service to increase apprenticeship starts across our sector. The AL Pledge service was introduced to give employers more control over how their unspent AL funds are used. Pledges give employers more choice about where their money can go – employers can set the criteria including location, sector, type of job role and apprenticeship qualification level. Businesses that meet the criteria can then apply for the funds. So far, 25 construction employers have pledged almost £3m. This is a great start, and they would like to build on it in 2023 and double the number of pledges to 50. To support this ambition if you are an AL paying employer, we are asking you to consider pledging your unspent AL funds.
